



## My Recommended PE Equipment for Elementary Schools

All of this equipment are things that I currently have and use in PE and would recommend to others.

### Sports Teach Basketball Flag House

This ball provides useful visuals to teach various nuances in teaching basketball skills, as hand placement for shooting and applying pressure with the finger pads when dribbling.



### Alleyoop goals Gopher

Elementary gyms were designed to be used by adults in the community, teaching shooting in basketball to an 5 year old in a full size net is impossible for most. These nets provide more appropriate sized nets for younger kids, in 4 different sizes (I recommend the 6ft one for K-2 students), are easily transportable and reasonably priced.



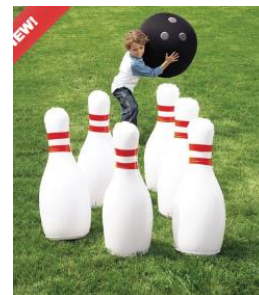
### Cannon Launcher Set Flag House

### Inflatable Bowling Set Flag House

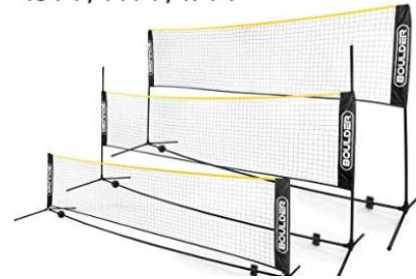
Can be used for all sorts I've used them for teaching rolling, volleyball serving, soccer shooting.
